***SUMMARY OF CHANGES**

Requirements for DoD-specified motorcycle training decals have been added to the supplement. Additionally, the installation commander or designee authorizes restricted driving privileges and determines if/when pass systems will be used. A margin bar indicates newly revised material.

*2.10.2. (ACC) The installation commander or designee authorizes restricted driving privileges and determines if/when pass systems will be used. The restricted individual must have in their possession and present a copy of the letter of authorization upon request.

***3.2. Registration and Driver Requirements.** All military personnel must accomplish DoD-specified motorcycle training before they operate motorcycles on or off base, on or off duty. All DoD civilian personnel must accomplish DoD-specified motorcycle training before they operate motorcycles on base. There is only one exception to this policy: Properly licensed operators may be granted a 72-hour temporary exemption (prior to completing the DoD-specified training) as long as they are scheduled to attend the training class within that 72-hour period. The temporary exemption is strictly for the purpose of allowing members to get their motorcycles to the training location on the day of training. Unit commander will provide documentation verifying that member is scheduled for the class. Unit commanders will ensure that ACC Form 15, *ACC Motorcycle Trained Decal*, is issued to riders once verification of training is provided.

*3.5.4. Individuals who have had their on-base driving privileges suspended or revoked will immediately remove registration decals from their vehicle(s) and return same to the vehicle registration office.

*4.2.3.1. (ACC) Motorcycles and mopeds. ACC active duty military and DoD civilian personnel must have a MSF completion certificate. An MSF completion certificate will be provided after the operator completes the motorcycle training required by AFI 91-207, *The US Air Force Traffic Safety Program*; motorcycle riding course, Basic Rider Course IV A or Experienced Rider Course IV B. ACC active duty military and DoD civilian will be issued an ACC Form 15 which will be placed on the left front side of the motorcycle. The motorcycle decal shows that the operator has received the required training. Unqualified active duty military personnel are prohibited from operating motorcycles on or off base. Unqualified DoD civilians are prohibited from operating motorcycles on base. ACC military and DoD civilian personnel must have a valid ACC Form 15 and MSF course completion card immediately available when operating a motorcycle on base. Operators of a government owned, leased or rented off-road motorcycle, or an officially classified dirt bike, operating off the street or roadway shall complete either the Military Motorcycle Operator Training Program (MILMO) or the MSF Dirt Bike School, as applicable. Personnel operating an ATV on an installation must complete a certified ATV rider's course and maintain the ATV Safety Institute Riders Course completion card on their person while operating an ATV. **NOTE:** Motorcycles will not be loaned to unqualified

military or civilian personnel. The owner is responsible for ensuring operators possess an MSF course completion card.

*4.2.3.2.1. Safety personnel may stop motorcycles operators during safety checks to ensure the required decal is affixed to the motorcycle.
