### What is it?

The Rhino Run is a 120 mile Time-Speed-Distance (TSD) rally through 4 Nebraska counties. It tests the ability of any rider on any make or model of motorcycle, to stay on the rally course and on time arriving at precise times at various hidden check points. It is held on public roads at or below posted speed limits.. Points are awarded for arriving early or late at the checkpoints. The rider with the lowest points accumulated wins.
